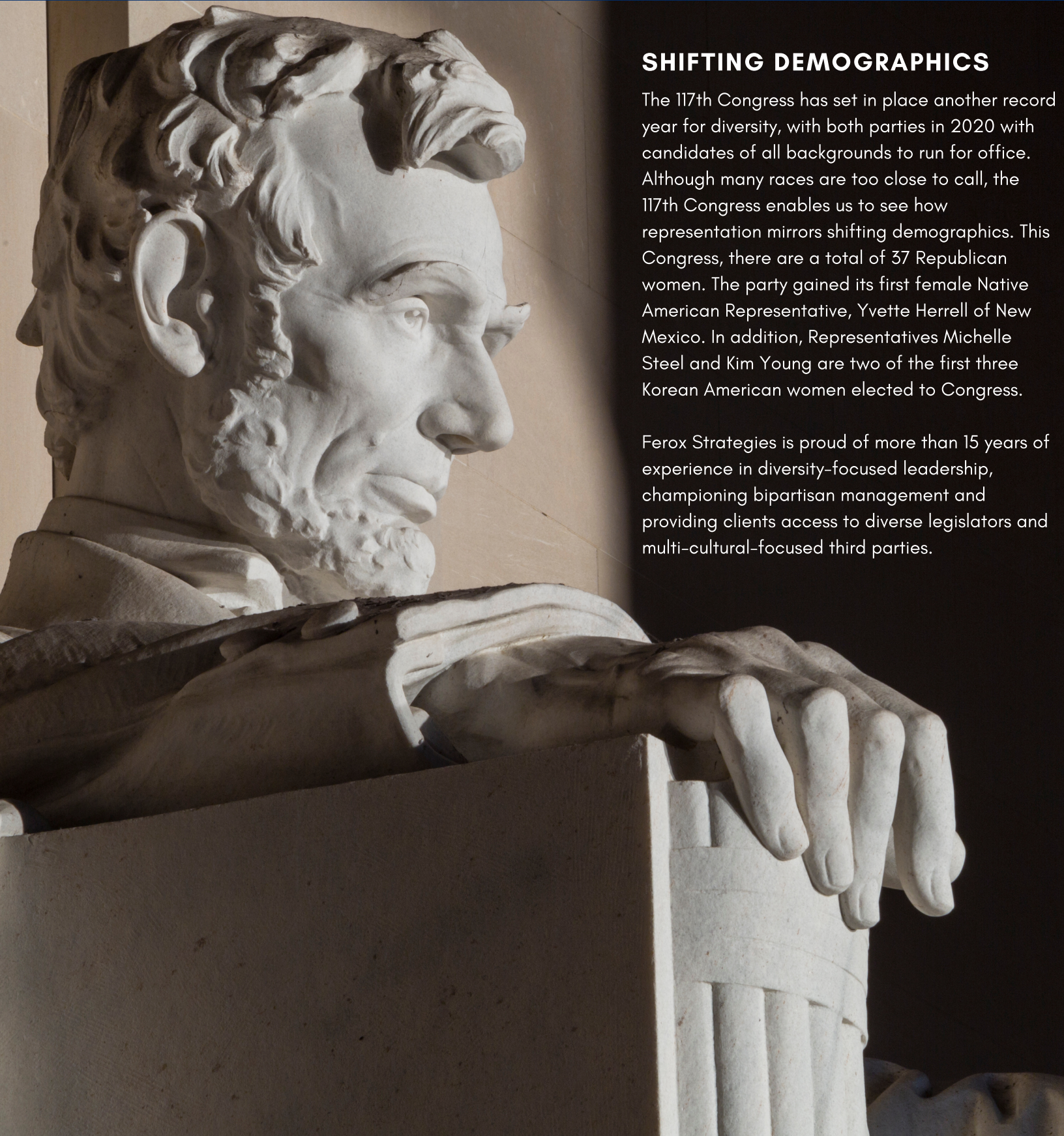




117th CONGRESS GOP DIVERSE MEMBERS
